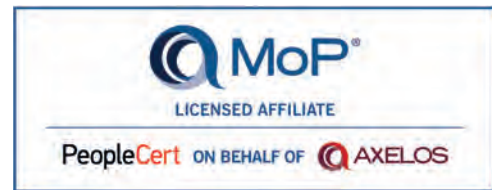

LEARNING OUTCOME

The Foundation and Practitioner course will enable students to demonstrate their ability to:

- Understand the fundamentals of MoP; Define the business case to get senior management approval for portfolio management;
- Plan the implementation of portfolio management;
- Select and adapt MoP principles, practices and techniques to suit different organisational environments;
- Evaluate examples of MoP information (including documents and role descriptions);
- Analyse the solutions adopted in relation to a given scenario; and
- Be fully prepared to undertake the Practitioner exam.

AUDIENCE

MoP Combined course is suitable for professionals involved in a range of formal and informal portfolio management roles encompassing investment decision making, project and programme delivery, and benefits realisation.

COURSE CONTENT

The following topics will be covered in the Foundation Course:

- ✓ Introduction: What is portfolio management?;
- ✓ Value management and its the strategic and organisational context;
- ✓ Portfolio management principles;
- ✓ Portfolio management cycles;
- ✓ Portfolio definition practices;
- ✓ Portfolio delivery practices;
- ✓ Portfolio management documents;
- ✓ Portfolio management roles and responsibilities; and
- ✓ Preparation for the Foundation Examination.

The Practitioner course is scenario based, and focuses on the application of MoP under different programme environments and scenarios. Students will work through a range of exercises and case studies in order to broaden and deepen their understanding of Portfolio Management and to prepare for the exam.

If students successfully pass the exam they will be issued with MoP Foundation and Practitioner Certification and Digital Badge
